

AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made this _____ day of _____, _____, by and between _____ (“Performers”) and the Lower Paxton Youth Center (“LPYC”).

DEFINITIONS

Performers shall be defined as individuals or a collective unit including all members of a band.

LPYC shall be defined as host of the event or activity and can include the LPYC Board of Directors, employees, volunteers, or Youth Advisory Council (“YAC”) members.

Representative shall be defined as a band member or manager of the Performers.

COMPENSATION

1. Performers **do not** receive any **monetary compensation** for performing at the LPYC.
2. Performers and their guests will each receive a food item and drink(s) at the discretion of the LPYC.
3. Performers having more than two (2) members will be permitted two (2) guests per band – **not two (2) guests per performer**– who will not be charged admittance. Guests should primarily be people selling the Performers’ merchandise or setting up and tearing down the Performers’ equipment.
4. Performers may utilize one (1) table provided by the LPYC for selling Performers’ merchandise. The LPYC may prohibit the sale of items it deems offensive or inappropriate.

RULES, REGULATIONS, AND RESTRICTIONS

Performers must observe the attached Rules and Regulations for Events. The LPYC may terminate a performance at any time if any rules are violated. If the LPYC terminates a performance, Performers are required to tear down their equipment immediately and, if requested by the LPYC, leave the premises. The LPYC reserves the right to call the local police if circumstances warrant such action.

The LPYC may review any other violations of this Agreement by Performers to determine the consequences of such violations. The consequences may include, but are not limited to, reporting the circumstances to local police and banning Performers from performing or attending future events.

1. Performers will be scheduled to play at specific times determined by the LPYC, based on the number of bands performing and other time constraints. The last Performers on the schedule must stop playing by 10:00 PM and all Performers must have their equipment loaded by no later than 10:30 PM, at which time they must leave the parking lot.
2. The LPYC will not be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged equipment brought onto the property by the Performers. The LPYC will hold equipment that is left behind by Performers for two (2) months. If the equipment is not claimed and picked up within two (2) months, it will become the property of the LPYC to use or dispose of solely at their discretion.
3. Only members of the LPYC Board of Directors, employees, volunteers, YAC officers, and Performers will be allowed on stage during any performance. No guests will be permitted on stage except while setting up or tearing down the Performers’ equipment.
4. If an event or activity must be canceled for bad weather or some other reason, the LPYC will contact the Performers’ representative listed on this Agreement as soon as possible. The LPYC will attempt to reschedule the performance at a later date.
5. If the Performers deem it necessary to cancel a performance for any reason, a representative is expected to notify the LPYC Center Director as soon as possible at Lpyouthcenter@gmail.com.

SPECIAL BAND REQUIREMENTS

Performers are required to be present at least one (1) hour before their performance. They must also have a representative who knows their musical needs at check-in (time to be specified) on the day of the scheduled performance to make necessary decisions for them. If they are not represented at check-in, the LPYC may replace the Performers on the schedule. If Performers are not allowed to play, they may be permitted to remain as observers but each member and guest must pay the entrance fee.

LOWER PAXTON YOUTH CENTER
RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR EVENTS

The rules and regulations of the LPYC apply to both attendees and performers. **Anyone who breaks a rule must leave immediately. No alibis or explanations will be accepted.** The following items and activities are strictly forbidden:

Alcohol	Violence
Drugs	Vandalism
Weapons	Harassment
Smoking (inside the building or in the open doorways)	Crowd Surfing

Dance at your own risk. The LPYC will not be responsible for any injury incurred by an attendee or a performer during a performance, including any injury incurred while performing, dancing, “moshing,” or taking part in any other activity while watching a performance. Spectators need to avoid the area immediately in front of the stage if other attendees are dancing or “moshing” there.

Treat everyone with respect. Attendees and performers are expected to display a cooperative and respectful attitude toward other attendees and performers and the volunteer staff and employees of the LPYC. If anyone displays behavior or uses language of a threatening, degrading, or offensive nature toward another individual or group, the employees and volunteer staff will take whatever action they deem necessary under the circumstances. Such action may include, but is not limited to, banning the offender from attending future events and activities.

Damages. Attendees and performers will be held responsible for any and all damage they do to LPYC property.

No loitering. No loitering in the building or the parking lot is permitted after the last scheduled performance or activity. Attendees and performers must leave the building promptly unless they are helping to tear down equipment or clean up.

Stay off the school grounds after dusk. The Lower Paxton Township police patrol the property of the E. H. Phillips Elementary School after sundown. They will issue warnings and may issue citations to anyone on the playground, the athletic fields, or the wooded and grass-covered areas adjacent to the LPYC parking lot.
